HIGHLIGHTS

- The multi-agency cholera Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) at NCDC continues to coordinate the response
- Zamfara state has shown increasing number of cases since week 34, meanwhile, Borno, Adamawa and Gombe states are reporting a new outbreak in new LGAs
- 29 cases reported from Gombe state with 3 deaths. State yet to send in linelist data.
- No cases reported in the following states in the last three or more weeks: Anambra, Bauchi, Ebonyi, FCT, Gombe, Jigawa, Kaduna, Kogi, Nasarawa, Niger, Plateau, Sokoto and Yobe States

EPI-Summary

- In week 36 (3rd 9th September); 1306 new suspected cases were reported from five states-Zamfara (588), Katsina (377), Borno (388), Adamawa (55) and Kano (6), with 24 deaths (12 in Katsina and 12 in Zamfara)
- In the reporting week, five samples were collected. Two in Katsina and Kano respectively and one in Zamfara, all five were tested and positive using Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT)
- As at 10th September, 2018, a total of 27,927 suspected cases including 517 deaths with CFR: (1.85%) have been reported from 19 States (Adamawa, Anambra, Bauchi, Borno, Ebonyi, FCT, Gombe, Jigawa, Kaduna, Kano, Katsina, Kebbi, Kogi, Nasarawa, Niger, Plateau, Yobe, Sokoto and Zamfara) <u>since the beginning of 2018</u>.
- No reports received from Sokoto in week 35:
- Of the confirmed cases, 25.97 % are aged 5 -14 years
- Of the suspected cases, 50.1% are female and 49.8% are male






Nigeria: States/LGAs affected by Cholera, Wk01-36 2018














Zamfara: Reported Cholera Cases by Week, WK01-36 2018
