

BEFORE AN OUTBREAK		
CASE MANAGEMENT	<ul> <li>Pre-knowledge of designated Viral Haemorrhagic Fevers (VHFs) laboratories and testing centres as well as distribution of list of focal persons in these laboratories</li> <li>Train designated phlebotomist on sample collection, packaging and transportation</li> <li>Develop Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for safe handling of samples</li> <li>Conduct audits of human personnel, equipment, reagents and consumables in designated VHF testing laboratories.</li> <li>Ensure adequate stock of consumables/reagents.</li> <li>Ensure designated laboratories have SOPs in place to promote quality service</li> </ul>	
INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC)	• Good knowledge of bio-safety requirements for VHF samples handling	
SURVEILLANCE	<ul> <li>Understand the reporting and feedback process to sample originating States and the Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC)</li> <li>Laboratory data management system should be clearly defined and functional.</li> </ul>	

DURING AN OUTBREAK		
CASE MANAGEMENT	<ul> <li>VHF sample collection by trained personnel in appropriate PPEs</li> <li>Inform designated laboratory about samples which are being sent from the State</li> <li>Ensure triple package and ship samples to designated VHF testing laboratory</li> <li>Result released within the shortest turnaround time</li> <li>Establish communication of results with State Epidemiologist and referring health facility</li> </ul>	
INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC)	<ul><li>Bio-safety measures to be complied with during sample collection</li><li>Proper waste management in accordance with stipulated guidelines</li></ul>

DURING AN OUTBREAK	
SURVEILLANCE	<ul> <li>24hr/day testing to be available during outbreak</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Establish communication with surveillance team for sharing of outbreak reports</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Result sharing and harmonization of laboratory results with surveillance data</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Notify State Epidemiologist of sample originating State when sample is received from other sources.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Provide feedback to State Epidemiologist on sample result as soon as testing is completed.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensure NCDC is equally notified of the sample result.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Sample result can be shared via SMS, or voice call. Either way, email (including scanned copy of laboratory form) should be sent to respective States copying NCDC Surveillance.</li> </ul>
