

HIGHLIGHTS

- This is the eighth situation report for 2018/2019 season
- The National Technical Working Group for Cerebrospinal Meningitis has been monitoring cases and ensuring preparedness and coordination of response across the states
- States in the meningitis belt were formally placed on alert on the 8th of November 2018
- As at epi week 6, 2019 five new suspected case were reported.
- Beginning from 1st October, 2018 to 5th February 2019, a total of 201 suspected cases have been reported from thirteen states
- Eighteen samples were positive for bacterial meningitis
- Neisseria meningitides serogroup C (NmC) accounted for 33.3% (5) of the positive cases
- So far, sixteen deaths (CFR=8.0%) have been recorded among all suspected cases
- In the last four weeks (Epi Wk2 to Epi Wk5,2019), no LGA is in the alert threshold
- Media messages have been developed and disseminated via conventional and social media
- The multi-agency CSM Emergency Operation Centre (EOC) has been activated
- Monitoring of situation continues across the high risk states
