


HIGHLIGHTS

- This is the 14th situation report for 2018/2019 season
- The National Cerebrospinal Meningitis Emergency Operations Centre has been monitoring cases and ensuring preparedness and coordination of response across the states
- States in the meningitis belt were formally placed on alert on the 8th of November 2018
- As at Epi week 11, 2019, three new suspected cases were reported.
- Beginning from 1st October, 2018 to 17th March, 2019, a total of **395 suspected** cases have been reported from 14 states
- Forty-three (43) samples were positive for bacterial meningitis: Nm C 16 (37.2%), Spn 18 (41.9%), Hib 6 (13.6%), Nm X 4 (9.1%)
- So far, Forty-Four deaths (CFR=11.1%) have been recorded among all suspected cases
- In the last four weeks (Epi Wk 8 to Epi Wk 11, 2019), no LGA is in the alert threshold
- Media messages have been developed and disseminated via conventional and social media
- The multi-agency CSM Emergency Operation Centre (EOC) has been activated
- Monitoring of situation continues across the high risk states


Figure 1: Epidemic Curve of CSM cases in Nigeria – Week 25, 2018 - Week 11, 2019
