



COVID-19 OUTBREAK IN NIGERIA

HIGHLIGHTS

This is the 29th national situation report, following confirmation of the first case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in Nigeria on 27th February 2020. The data in this report is as at 12 midnight on 28/03/2020

- On the 28th of March 2020, **16** new confirmed cases of COVID-19 were recorded in Nigeria
- All new cases were reported from FCT (2), Kaduna (1), Osun (1), Oyo (4), Lagos (7) and Benue (1) States
- The 97 confirmed cases are in 12 States (Lagos 59, FCT 16, Oyo 7, Ogun 3, Bauchi 2, Edo 2, Enugu, 2, Osun 2, Benue 1, Ekiti 1, Kaduna 1 and Rivers 1); three (3) cases have been discharged, 93 currently receiving care and **one death** from COVID-19 in Nigeria
- The National EOC is working with affected State EOCs to identify contacts of the new confirmed cases
- A cumulative total of 6,238 passengers of interest (POI) identified, and being monitored
- A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at level 3, continues to coordinate national response activities

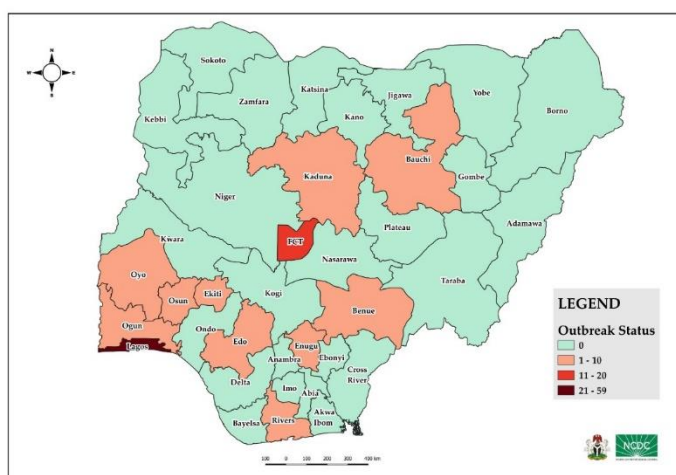


Fig. 1: Map of Nigeria showing COVID-19 affected States

MAJOR RESPONSE ACTIVITIES

- Deployment of Rapid Response Team (RRT) to support Kaduna and Benue

COVID-19 Situation Report

- One new laboratory (UCH Ibadan) added to network of COVID-19 testing laboratories, bringing the total number of testing laboratories to six.
- Six laboratories with PCR testing capacity to be assessed and added to existing laboratory network for COVID-19 sample testing
- Daily EOC meetings held at NCDC, Edo, Oyo, Lagos, Ekiti and FCT
- Contact tracing of new confirmed cases commenced
