## HIGHLIGHTS

- This is the $15^{\text {th }}$ situation report for 2018/2019 season
- The National Technical Working Group for Cerebrospinal Meningitis has been monitoring cases and ensuring preparedness and coordination of response across the states
- States in the meningitis belt were formally placed on alert on the $8^{\text {th }}$ of November 2018
- As at epi week 12, 201915 new suspected cases were reported in 2 states.
- Beginning from $1^{\text {st }}$ October, 2018 to $27^{\text {th }}$ March, 2019, a total of $\mathbf{5 4 1}$ suspected cases have been reported from 15 states
- Forty-seven samples were positive for bacterial meningitis
- Neisseria meningitides serogroup C (NmC) accounted for $34.0 \%$ (16) of the positive cases
- So far, 48 deaths (CFR=8.9\%) have been recorded among all suspected cases
- In the last four weeks (Epi Wk9 to Epi Wk12,2019), one LGA is in the epidemic threshold
- Media messages have been developed and disseminated via conventional and social media. The multi-agency CSM Emergency Operation Centre (EOC) has been activated
