



COVID-19 OUTBREAK IN NIGERIA

HIGHLIGHTS

This is the 30th national situation report, following confirmation of the first case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in Nigeria on 27th February 2020. The data in this report is as at 12 midnight on 29/03/2020

- On the 29th of March 2020, **fourteen new** confirmed cases of COVID-19 were recorded in Nigeria
- All new cases were reported from FCT (5), and Lagos (9) States
- Currently, there is a total of 111 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Nigeria
- The 111 confirmed cases are in 12 States (Lagos 69, FCT 21, Oyo 7, Ogun 3, Bauchi 2, Edo 2, Enugu, 2, Osun 2, Benue 1, Ekiti 1, Kaduna 1 and Rivers 1); three (3) cases have been discharged, 93 currently receiving care and **one death** from COVID-19 in Nigeria
- Of the 111 confirmed cases 75 (68%) have travel history to high risk countries, 18(16%) are contacts of known confirmed cases and 18 (16%) of cases have incomplete epidemiological information
- The National EOC is working with affected State EOCs to identify contacts of the new confirmed cases
- A cumulative total of **6,545** passengers of interest (POI) identified, and being monitored
- A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at level 3, continues to coordinate national response activities

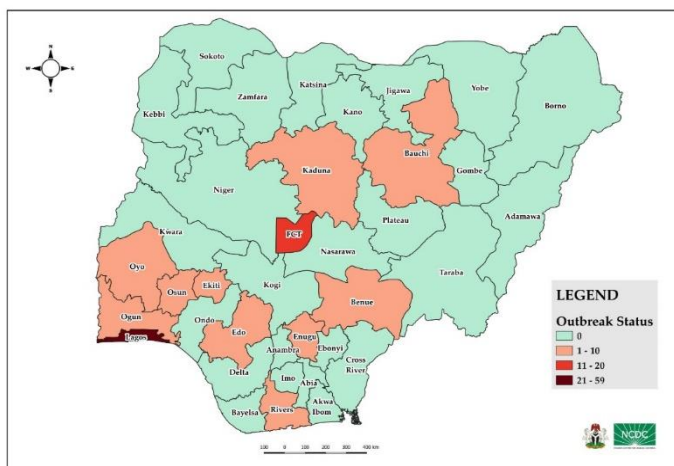


Fig. 1: Map of Nigeria showing COVID-19 affected States

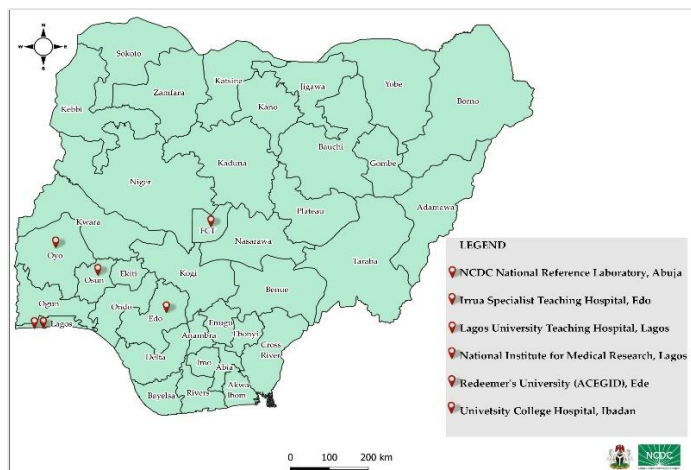


Fig. 2: Map of Nigeria showing COVID-19 testing laboratories

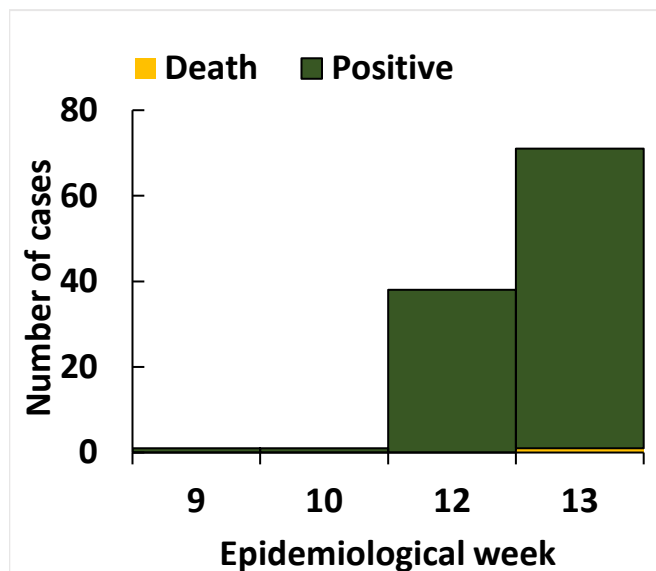


Fig. 3: Epi-Curve of Confirmed Cases (wk9 – wk13)

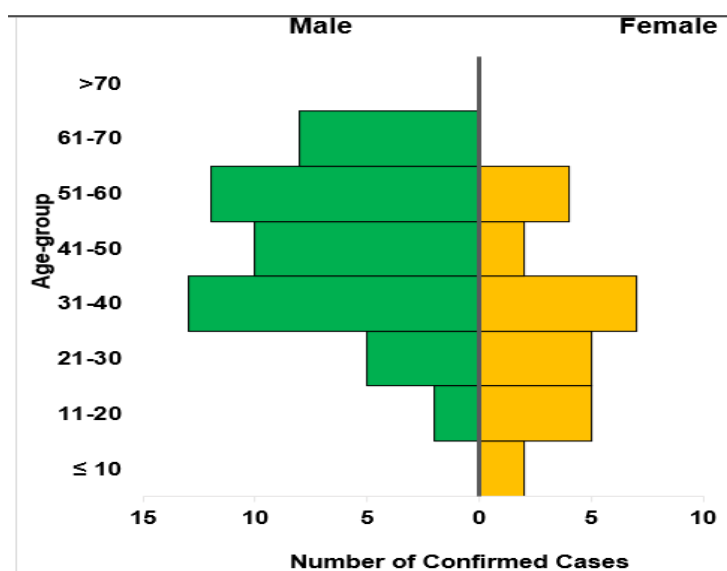


Fig. 4: Age-Sex distribution of Confirmed Cases (wk9 – wk13)
